

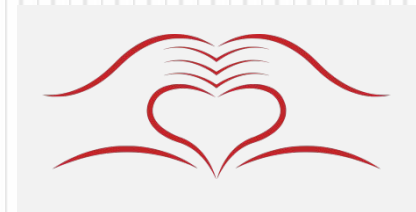

- A village member/volunteer is ready to help seniors to get the support they need.

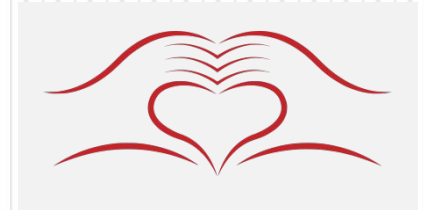
